Four B.C. juniors took the opportunity to play in this traditional Seattle August event. Jack Cheng finished with 3.5/5, Richard Huang and Arik Milner scored 3 (the latter including a victory over FM David Bragg), and Donovan Zhao achieved 50% against much higher-rated opposition. Overall winners of the Seafair were John Ready and Benjamin Calpo, who tied with 4.5 (each took a bye in the fourth round) in the sixty-two player field. **HZ OPEN (August 4-11)**

As noted in Bulletin #112, former B.C. resident IM Leon Piasetski has become active again after a lengthy hiatus from chess. Now fifty-five and clean shaven, he recently took part in another tournament, the 11th annual Hogeschool Zeeland (HZ) Open in Vlissingen, the Netherlands. The event was won by Fabiano Caruana, who just turned fifteen and is about to become the youngest American-born GM ever. His 7.5/9 score was matched by three others (GM Sergei Tiviakov, IM Ralf Appel, and FM Miqchiel De Jong), but Caruana had the better tiebreak. Tied for fourth were GMs Michal Krasenkow, Rustam Kasimdzhanov, Dibyendu Barua, Oleg Romanishin, and FM Lorin D'Costa, all with 7 points. Piasetski finished with 6.0/9 to tie for twentieth in the two hundred and fifty player field.
