## 1957 CANADIAN CHAMPIONSHIP

Fifty years ago the Canadian Championship was held for only the second time on the West Coast. The first occasion had been in 1951; that tournament, held at the Hotel Vancouver, attracted thirteen representatives from all except the Maritime provinces and was won by Paul Vaitonis of Hamilton, Ontario. The 1957 Championship was also held at the Hotel Vancouver and was again won by Vaitonis, but in many ways it was a lesser affair. Only ten players took part (and two of these, Vaitonis and Ridout, were late entrants) from a total of just three provinces, with B.C. players making up the bulk of the field. Missing in comparison with the 1951 event were the likes of Yanofsky, Bohatirchuk, Fox, Yerhoff, and Divinsky, and as can be seen from the crosstable there was a significant divide between the top five players and the rest.

Why this was is hard to say at this distance; certainly there doesn't seem to have been the same level of support from the top players or from the chess community in general. In 1951 donations toward the championship tournament totalled some \$1,788, while six years later the same figure was only \$1,265. The difference is most noticeable in the tournament publications: the 1951 book ran to over fifty pages and included photos, player biographies, round summaries, and an openings survey, whereas the 1957 'equivalent' contains merely the moves of the games on fourteen mimeographed sheets.

Despite these differences the 1957 Championship was still a hard-fought event, with the title only being decided in the very last round. As fate would have it the four eventual top placers were paired against each other in the first round; the resultant draws allowed Joyner and Potter to temporarily take the lead at the expense of the other B.C. players, while Jursevskis placed a significant dent in reigning champion Anderson's chances by defeating him in round two. Joyner dispatched Potter to take the sole lead in round three, but consecutive losses in rounds four and five (a short debacle against Fuster followed by a long losing effort against Vaitonis) put him out of the running. The tournament turned into a two-man race in round five when Fuster beat Jursevskis, but in round seven Fuster gave up a costly draw to tail-ender May, giving Vaitonis the undisputed lead. Both Vaitonis and Fuster won in round eight, setting up their dramatic last-round encounter. Vaitonis dismantled Fuster's exchange Queen's Gambit, thus gaining the Canadian crown for the second time, while Jursevskis was unable to overcome Potter and ended the tournament tied for third with Anderson.

Rounds were held at 7 pm each evening, with adjournments played out the following afternoon; the time control was forty moves in two and a half hours. The Canadian Speed Chess Championship was held on the penultimate day of the tournament (ten seconds a move), and despite a relatively poor showing in the main event Frank May gave up only one draw to Fuster in winning the speed crown - apparently the first time a national title was held by a B.C. resident.
