VANCOUVER JUNIOR/ADULT GRAND PRIX

When this year's Grand Prix was first organized and advertised, it was based on last year's Grand Prix, i.e., the best scores from six out of eight events with a \$1250 prize fund. However, circumstances have forced the modification of this schedule; due to the necessity of running early CYCC events this year, the two Grand Prix tournaments which should have occurred in February and March have been cancelled. The Grand Prix is now going to be run as a six-event

series (April 17 and May 15 are the last two events), with a player's best four results counting toward the Grand Prix prizes. The overall prizes will also be reduced in quantity and size, due to the lesser number of tournaments and smaller event turnouts.
